- No. 2.—A grand Aquatic Handicap Steeplechase over hurdles. Open to all comers. Four lengths. Prize, a splendid gold medal.
- No. 3.—A Handicap Race. Open to all residents within a radius of seven miles of the baths; six lengths of the bath.
- No. 4.—A Scratch Race, six lengths of the bath. Open to residents of Tyldesley and district who reside within a radius of two miles of the baths, that have never won a prize. Prize, a splendid silver medal.
- No. 5.—A Consolation Handicap, Hurdle Race, 4 lengths. This race is open to defeated competitors in Nos. 1, 2, 3, and 4, who are residents within two miles of the baths. Prize, a good Ham.
- No. 6.—A Grand Exhibition of Ornamental Swimming; motion, less floating; double floating; sculling on the back, feet first; ditto, head first; sculling on the breast, feet first; swimming like a duck; swimming without using arms; swimming with one leg up on the back; walking round the head on the surface of the water; representations of E. P. Weston in deep water; swimming the length of the bath on the back, with push and two strokes; long plunge; the water pyramids; spinning like a top; revolving head over heels on the surface of the water; somersaults from the shoulder; forming star; dying gladiator; saving each other; waiting for help; new game of leap frog on the surface of the water; swimming each other; one in distress; by
